- Discover a new plant and safely collect a sample from it. Example: the leaf from a new kind of tree.
- Find an animal that is local to your area and observe it's behaviors. What did you learn about it's habits or ecosystem?
- Go for a hike or walk and try only using hand signals to communicate with your party. Plan ahead and bonus points if it's over a mile long.
- Next time you travel somewhere new take a compass with you and track the directions you go in.
- Try to build a fort outside that could survive a rainy day. Plan ahead and see if you stay dry. If you don't want to get wet test it with a waterproof item at home. *(Please don't try this during any thunder and lightning)*
- Journal each day for one week! You can be a short writer like Clark, who would write just the weather some days, or a more descriptive writer like Lewis.
